

AKKESHI "BOSHU" 2021

The 3rd release in Akkeshi's "24 Solar Terms" series. Based upon a lunar calendar dating back to the age of samurai, Japan divides its year into 24 seasons that reflect very specific moments of time. "Boshu"(loosely translates to "The Sowing of Grain") typically begins on July 9th and is considered the ideal time to plant seeds and when flickering fireflies begin to appear (as depicted on label).

"Boshu" Peated Single Malt consists of both British & locally grown two-row barley that has been peated with locally grown peat with the spirit then matured in a combination of ex-bourbon, red wine, sherry & locally grown Mizunara oak casks.

Notes of milk chocolate, dried fruit & a touch of sweet bonfire followed by a soft cocoa salty bitterness & a citrus-like sweetness
