



Akkeshi Blended Whisky Daikan

HOKKAIDO, JAPAN

Akkeshi's Daikan blended whisky is the sixth release in their "24 Seki Series" following Ritto and representative of Japan's coldest season, "The Peak of Winter." This release is a blend of imported new pot grain whisky that is aged at Akkeshi for a minimum of 3 years in ex-bourbon barrels before combining with a majority of their own mizunara, sherry, and red wine cask aged single malt. The richness of the pot stillled grain whisky and peated, mizunara aged malt mingle to create a sturdy dram fit for the coldest winter days when one can fortify until the snows thaw.
