This third edition of Three Societies' foundational series of Korean single malt whiskies is titled Eagle, the representative animal of the United States. The eagle not only symbolizes Korean American owner Brian Do but also the birthplace of the virgin oak used to age the Ki One whiskies. This whisky saw just over two years in new American oak barrels and is bottled at cask strength. The nose offers sweet oak and summer fruits while the palate yields flavors of sweet vanilla, spiced peaches, and banana before giving way to rich toffee and pine.

THREE SOCIETIES

Located just forty minutes from Seoul in Namyangju, Three Societies is Korea's first craft distillery focusing on single malt spirits. Founded by Korean American Brian Do, and Scottish Master Distiller Andrew Shand in June of 2020, their aim is to make world class malt spirits reflective of Korea's culture and terroir. With an uncompromising focus on quality, their ethos displays the duality of reflective tradition and progressive innovation.
