NAMYANGJU. SOUTH KOREA

The Unicorn is the second of three opening whisky releases from Korea's first single malt distillery Three Societies. Ki wan (Ki One) in Korean translates to "the beginning and hope." Being the second of three animal guardians adorning the distiller's crest, the Unicorn is representative of master distiller Andrew Shand's birthplace Scotland. Like the Tiger Edition before it, this single malt whisky was part of the same distillation run on July 7th of 2020 but was aged further through Korea's fall and winter seasons. The youthful spice of the Tiger Edition recedes somewhat to make room for the caramelized pop of sweet barley, banana, and stewed peaches. The Unicorn Edition is a masterful evolution of this whisky, displaying what additional aging in colder seasons can impart.
