Ki No Bi's Edition K is the result of a one-of-a-kind partnership with independent scotch whisky distillers Kilchoman. Located on the small Hebridean island of Islay off the western coast of Scotland, Kilchoman is a small scale, farm-based distillery known for peated whisky made from the barley that they grow. This unique release is Kyoto Distilling's Ki No Bi Kyoto Dry Gin matured in ex-bourbon barrels that previously contained Kilchoman's peated malt for just shy of a year. The result is an incredibly special barrel aged gin that displays all the smokey complexity of Kilchoman and marries it with Ki No Bi's own harmonious botanical nuance.
