TASTING NOTES

Nose: Lemon cake, black tea and a whiff of smoke. Deep sweet aroma like cacao, sweetened bean paste, butter toast and milk candy follows over time. Very complex aroma.

Palate: Bitterness and fruitiness like orangette spreads.

Finish: Long and warming sweetness lingers.

MARS HOMBO

Mars Whisky is located between Japan's soaring Southern Alps and the towering Central Alps. The Hombu family have been distilling for more than a century and added whisky to their repertoire in 1949. At that time the distillery was located in the Tsunuki region of Kagoshima Prefecture on the southern-most island of Kyushu.

Until 1984, it was the southernmost whisky made in Japan, which ended when the Hombu clan moved the distillery to the idyllic alpine setting of Miyada village in southern Nagano Prefecture, Central Japan. They chose this site for its cool temperature, which slowed maturation, and the plentiful soft granite filtered snowmelt fed aquifers.

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
